### REFLECTION

Sisters and brothers in Christ, the Lord is good. All the time. All the time. The Lord is good.

Advent is upon us. Today is the first Sunday of Advent and it marks the beginning of the new liturgical year C. Advent is a time of expectant waiting and preparation for both the celebration of the Nativity of Christ at Christmas and the return of Christ at the Second Coming. Advent 2021 begins today.

Sunday November 28th, and ends on Friday, December 24. 'Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy, from carousing and drunkenness and the anxieties of daily life, ...'.

Beloved in Christ, these are the words Christ addresses to us in today's gospel passage. They say it all: watch! He goes on to tell us how we are to watch; '... at all times.' These are the characteristics of the period in the Church's calendar we have begun today – the season of Advent. We are invited during this season to focus on the Lord's coming. The coming of the Lord can be a moment of condemnation rather than joy for us we are not prepared. When we hear of the Lord's coming, our minds go immediately to Christmas. However, Christmas is not the only coming of Christ that we are reminded to think about during this season. There is a second coming that will come to each of us at a time we least expect it. And there is a third, which is the final coming. For all these comings, the church warns us to be prayerfully vigilant.

Beloved in Christ, let us do all we can to secure a pleasant eternity for ourselves by accepting Christ in our hearts and allowing him rule and guide our lives. This will make us experience him at his third coming as righteous Judge who will allow us a full share in his glory – and it is for this that he made us.

Survivors of all forms of abuse across the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston, WV are invited to attend a special retreat entitled, "The Way." The Way is 3-day guided meditation and prayer program for men and women crafted around the Stations of the Cross. It is an opportunity for healing and prayer and for survivors to reflect on God's plan for their lives through prayer and sacraments. There will be opportunities for individual counseling and spiritual direction. Sponsored by the Archdiocese of Washington, the retreat is free of charge and will be held in February 18-20, 2022, for women. To register for the Preparation Class, please call the Parish Office at 304-754-7830.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: Will be held Wednesday evening from 6—7 PM and before Saturday Mass. Confession also available by appointment at anytime. Please call the Parish Office to schedule an appointment.

Rite of Christian Initiation: RCIA (for children 15 and older and adults) or RCIC (for children 7-14 yrs of age). For more information call the Parish Office at 304-754-7830. Preparation for receiving First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation, call the Parish Office at 304-754-7830.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples planning to marry at St. Bernadette Catholic Church should be practicing Catholics, participating in Sunday Eucharist regularly. Also they must participate in a Marriage Preparation Program. Call the Parish Office for information. At least six months notice is required. No date for a wedding will be set over the phone.

Holy Communion to the Sick and Homebound: When a Parishioner is confined to home or hospital because of illness or advanced age, call the Parish Office. We will be happy to make arrangements to bring Holy Communion.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Upon request and Communally as scheduled.

Parish Membership: We give a heartfelt welcome to all new people moving into our Parish. You can get a registration form from the Parish Office. Those who plan to move from our Parish Community are asked to inform us.


